- Best practices for energy management in vineyards and wineries
 - Information on renewable energy opportunities
- Update on PG&E programs including: free winery energy audits, equipment rebates, technical support services and new resources, and
- Development of an action plan for improving practices and scores in the energy efficiency chapter of the Code of Sustainable Winegrowing Workbook.

The energy workshops are **free of charge** to participants and are funded through PG&E's energy efficiency programs under the auspices of the California Public Utilities Commission.

The workshops are being held in response to findings in the **California wine community's 2004 Sustainability Report**, which indicated that energy use was an area that offered wineries and vineyards opportunities for improvement for energy savings.

The energy workshops augment the **self-assessment workshops** and **other action plan workshops** on topics such as integrated pest management, ecosystem management, and air and water quality, hosted by CSWA as part of the California wine community's Sustainable Winegrowing Program.
